



Blueprint to Hungarian citizenship

1. Documents Required

- Valid passport or photo ID
- Birth certificate (original and certified copies)
- Proof of residence in Hungary (if applicable)
- Proof of Hungarian descent (if applying through ancestry)
 - birth certificate or baptismal records
- Marriage certificate (ancestors' and yours if applicable)

2. Request Form

- Complete the official Hungarian Naturalization Application Form.
 - Available at the Immigration and Asylum Office or Hungarian consulate [here](#).
- Complete the request form for [registering birth and marriage](#) (if applicable)

3. Translations

- All foreign documents must be officially translated into Hungarian by a certified translator.
- Both the original and the translated versions need to be submitted.
- Certified translations must be recognized by Hungarian authorities (e.g., OFFI – Hungarian Office for Translation and Attestation).

4. Book Appointment

- Schedule an appointment with the Hungarian Immigration and Asylum Office or your nearest Hungarian consulate.
- Appointments can often be made online through the respective office's website.
- Ensure you bring all necessary documents and forms to your appointment.
- Attend an interview (if required) regarding your application, eligibility, and Hungarian language skills.

Additional Notes:

- Processing Time: Citizenship applications can take several months to a year.
